

Programme contents

Module 1. History, Rules and Regulations, Statistics and Epidemiology, Evidence Based Maritime Medicine.

Module 2. National and International Organisation, Medical care and Preventive Maritime Medicine (including telemedicine, onboard medicine, medical fitness examinations), Working Conditions and Risk Prevention, Harbour, Navy, Tropical and Disaster Medicine, Toxicology, Hygiene, Survival and rescue at sea.

Modules 3 & 4. Underwater and Hyperbaric Medicine, Nautical Sports Medicine, Fitness medical examinations for professional divers and for nautical sports.

Practical. Telemedicine-advice consultation, visits on board, Maritime Medicine Centres, Hyperbaric chamber, rescue training and other recognised seminars and meetings.
